

## **TECHNICAL INFORMATION, USE AND MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS**

### **DESTINATION OF USE**

- Furniture must not be used for purposes other than those specified by the manufacturer.
- Furniture must not be used in extreme climatic conditions, such as particularly hot or particularly cold rooms. The use of furniture in areas with high humidity (such as inadequately insulated basements or not airy rooms) or with the presence of saltiness could compromise its use and durability.
- Furniture must be kept in dry storage.
- Furniture is not designed to support particularly heavy weights.

### **INSTALLATION**

- Furniture must be installed by qualified personnel with suitable equipment, following the fitting instructions carefully.
- During the installation handle the elements carefully.
- Any tampering or modification of the furniture not authorized by the manufacturer may compromise the duration, stability, performance or aesthetics and consequently void the warranty.

### **SAFETY STANDARDS**

- Furniture must be placed on horizontal and stable planes of appropriate size after checking the floor.
- Do not place the furniture near open flames.
- Do not put the furniture in contact with heat sources.
- Do not pour liquids on the surfaces. In case of accidental spillage, dry immediately.
- Do not scratch the surfaces.
- Do not drag objects without scratch-proof rubber on the surfaces.
- The continued exposure of furniture to sunlight can alter the colour of the surfaces compromising their aesthetics.
- Before moving the cabinets, remove the contents and close and lock doors and drawers.
- Do not drag the furniture.
- Do not climb, sit or lean on furniture, use them for purposes other than those provided by the manufacturer.
- Do not load shelves and drawers beyond what is allowed.
- Do not place heavy objects on suspended surfaces.
- Do not force the opening of locked doors and drawers.
- Do not hit the furniture especially the glass surfaces.
- Open doors and drawers using the appropriate handles where required.
- Do not force the opening of rotating mobile parts beyond their maximum opening.
- Do not hang yourself or hang objects from doors and drawers, especially if open.

- Do not leave doors and drawers open.

## **CARE AND MAINTENANCE**

- The lighting on the surfaces must be homogeneous to avoid on the long period colour differences, in particular on veneered or coated surface.
- Clean regularly the furniture with slightly wet soft cloths, using a little water or non-abrasive neutral detergents. In case of doubt, try cleaning a hidden or non-visible part.
- Do not spray liquids directly on the furniture, but spray the cleaning product on the cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cloths for cleaning.
- Do not use aggressive detergents or solvents.
- The fabrics should be brushed with soft, aspirated brushes. Immediately remove liquids or other substances with a soft cloth or a damp sponge.
- The leather-covered surfaces should be cleaned with a slightly wet cloth without rubbing vigorously, in the case of persistent stains use specific products for leather cleaning.

## **DISPOSAL**

- Do not dispose of furniture and related packages in the environment.
- Furniture at the end of their life cycle must be bring to the existing disposal structures according to the current regulations. The furniture before being given they must be carefully disassembled.
- Packages must be bring to the existing disposal structures according to the current regulations.
